Race Day Registration

Race day registration opens at 7:30 A.M MT. If your category is not sold out, add **\$10** to the fee. Race day registration closes 45 minutes before start of your race.

Timing Chip & Results

Timing chip included in entry fee. No chip = last place. Fee for unreturned chip is \$35.

Directions to Parking

FROM DENVER: Hwy 36 all the way through Boulder. Turn right on Neva Rd. Left on 39th.

FROM FORT COLLINS: Hwy 287 South. Right turn onty Hwy 66. Left onto 75th through Hygiene (turns into 73rd). Right turn onto Niwot Rd. (becomes 45th then Neva). Right on 39th. Please don't drive on course.

FROM GOLDEN: Hwy 93 to Boulder. Go all the way through town. North on Hwy 36. Turn right on Neva Rd. Left on 39th.

Feed Zone

Located just east of 49th on Oxoford Rd. (NORTH side of road only). Usually for races over 60 miles. Feed zone is 1 mile east of Start/Finish. Please pick up your trash. Feed zone parking only on east side of North 49th St., off of Neva Rd.

Race Rules All USAC & Collegiate Rules Apply www.usacycling.org

USAC Release waiver must be signed by all racers or parent/guardian for anyone 18 years or younger.

USAC license required for all USAC events.

USAC 1-day beginner license: \$10, only available on site for Cat 5 Men/Boys, Women who have never previously held a USAC license with a higher category in the discipline they are registering for.

USAC 1-Day Experienced license: \$25, only available to former USAC members - category 1,2,3,4 men/women. Must be purchased online at USAC.

Collegiate License Required in Collegiate Events.

Collegiate 1-day license available for \$10 and only available for Collegiate C events.

BRAC membership required for all USAC events.

BRAC 1-day membership: \$5, available on site with the exception of 1-day licensees and out state racers (BRAC 1-day membership exempt with USAC 1-day and out-of-state racers). Annual memberships available online at coloradocycling.org (Jr. bike/gear restrictions apply - see usacycling.org). Annuals are required to obtain points for Rocky Mtn Road Cup. competitions.
